All applications for our school (St Paul's Catholic School for Girls) will require the following documentation to be included with the application form to assist the Governor's correctly match each applicant to the correct Criteria Point:

- 1) Proof of your home address (e.g. a copy of council tax, gas or electricity bill (within last 6 months);
- 2) Copy of your daughter's Birth Certificate or passport;
- 3) Copy of your daughter's Baptism Certificate; and
- 4) a letter of support from your parish priest or the completed Supplementary Information Form.

This form and all documentation must come back directly to us for the Governors to look at your application and make a decision as to whether a place can be offered or not. A letter will be sent out to you once the Governors have looked at any applications letting you know their decision.

If no place is available your daughter's name will be added to the relevant Year Groups Waiting List.
