

Uniform expectations

Please see below examples of correct uniform. Your daughter should follow these uniform rules every day.



- Navy St. Paul's school jumper with yellow stripes
- White, open-necked, short sleeve school blouse (blue blouse in Year 11)
- Navy fore-gore skirt – must be knee-length, no shorter
- Black or navy tights
- Black or navy knee-high socks – not nylon
- Black shoes – no canvas style trainer shoes
- Long hair tied back fully
- Hair must be one natural colour
- No hair accessories, eg: beads, scarves, bandanas
- No jewellery – apart from one small pair of stud earrings in the lobe of each ear
- No make-up – including no false eyelashes
- No nail-varnish or false nails

PE kit

- Girls must only wear their PE kits on the days when they have timetabled PE lessons
- St. Paul's PE polo shirt
- St. Paul's PE zip-up jacket
- St. Paul's PE jogging bottoms
- St. Paul's PE skirt – however this should not be worn when travelling to school
- Plain trainers
- No jewellery
- Long hair tied back fully
