Dear Parents

It is with regret that I have to confirm that the Government have made the decision to close schools to most pupils in response to the Corona virus. We, therefore, have put plans in place to support your daughter and her learning for however long school could be closed.

She should organise herself as if she were in school, spending the allocated amount of time on each subject. Work will be set by teachers, according to the number of subject lessons your daughter has each week. This means that as well as the work set by her teachers, she should continue with her revision schedule.

All communications are going to be on Firefly, School Comms and the school website. We will keep you informed about Exam Board plans and any updates about the reopening of school as soon as we are made aware.
