Dear Year 11 Pupil

It is with regret that I have to confirm that the Government have made the decision to close schools to most pupils in response to the Corona virus. We, therefore, have put plans in place to support you and your learning for however long school could be closed.

Log onto Firefly each day for your work and prayer. You are in school for six and half hours a day, so you should follow your normal timetable. The expectation is that you will also do additional study as you do at the moment.

Work will be set by your teachers according to the number of lessons you have per week.

In some cases, they will set the work for all the lessons in one go – e.g. in English, where you have 5 lessons, you maybe set a project that will take you 5 x 50 minutes to complete. Or, in other cases, teachers will set work per lesson per day.

Each teacher will ask you to return work in different ways, so please follow instructions carefully.

Remember you must also use Maths Watch, Kerboodle, BBC Bitesize and the PiXL Apps for revision.

You can also email your teachers for any guidance and advice.

At this point we know that your GCSE exams will not take place in May or June. However, we do not know the Government's future plans. As soon as we are informed of their plans, we will, of course, immediately let you know. We suggest that you continue with your revision as planned.

You will not be disadvantaged in any way. Every pupil in the country will be having the same experience. When we are given guidance about the reopening of school, you will be informed immediately. We shall be in regular contact with your parents who will also be following the national and local news.

Remember to pause at 12 midday for the Angelus. It will be good to know that we will all be united in prayer at that time. Remember to pray for each other.

I will email you each day with any developments and be assured of our support.
