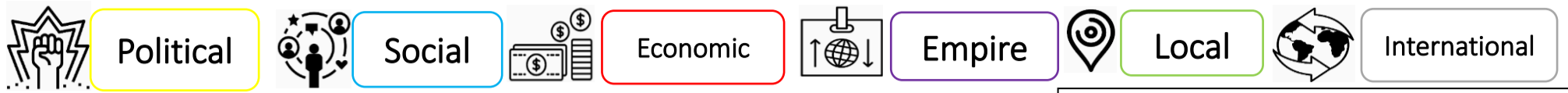


# St. Paul's School for Girls. KS5 History Curriculum Model

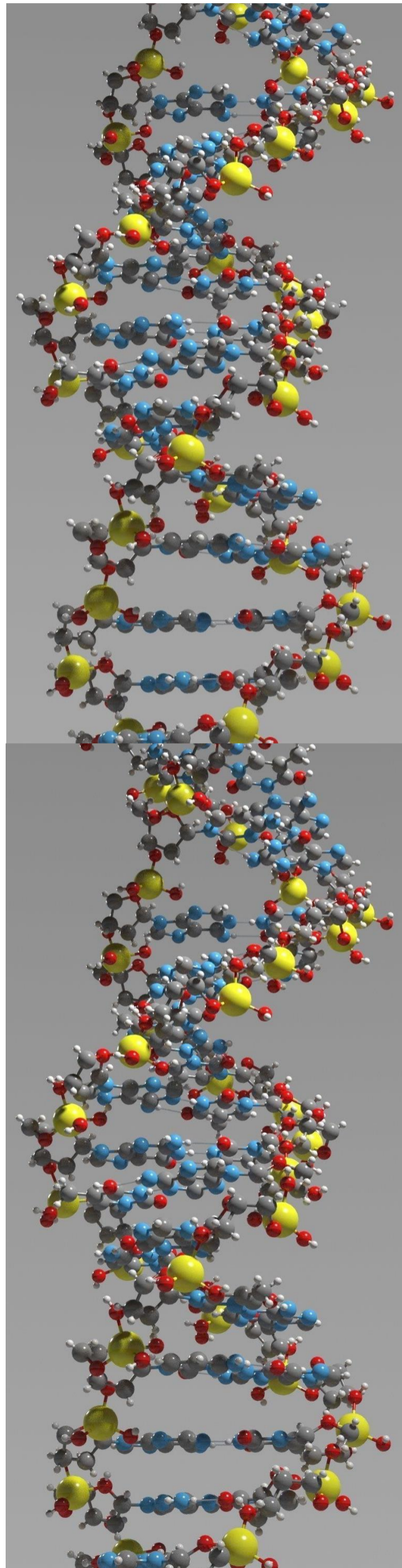
