**Application for a Change of School
(In-Year Admission)**

Following your recent request, please find enclosed a Birmingham Local Authority "Application for a Change of School (In-Year)" form for you to complete.

Before you complete this form and submit your preferences it is very important that you read a copy of the parents' information booklet called "Opportunities for your Child in Birmingham". There are different booklets for primary schools and secondary schools (including academies) in Birmingham. The booklets explain how your preferences will be dealt with, how school places are offered, the different types of schools and their admission criteria, where to get help with your application and what to do if you are not offered one of your preferred schools.

You can read the booklet online at www.birmingham.gov.uk/schooladmissions. Booklets are also available in all schools and libraries.

If your child is already attending a local school then moving your child to another school is a very serious step. It is important that you consider whether a move is really the best option. You should talk to your child's headteacher, or staff at your child's current school, before completing the enclosed form. If your child is experiencing difficulties at school a move to another school may not solve the problem. Talking to your child and staff at your child's current school can resolve most problems so that a move is avoided. Please ensure the headteacher of your child's current or most recent school completes the declaration in section 2 of the form.

Finally, may I remind you that your child must continue attending their current school until you are offered a new school place. Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child receives a suitable full-time education, either by regular attendance at school or otherwise (Education Act 1996, section 7). Parents who fail to ensure that their child attends regularly at the school at which they are a registered pupil are liable to prosecution (Education Act 1996, section 444). **In order to process your application as quickly as possible it is very important that you tell us which school your child is currently attending.**

If your child has a Statement of Special Educational Needs this form cannot be used to apply for a school place. You should instead contact SEN Assessment and Review for guidance on 0121 303 5684/85.

You should complete and return the enclosed form to your preferred school.

All applications for In-Year transfers must now be made directly to the schools of your choice using an Application for a Change of School (In-Year) form from the relevant authority that the school comes under. You will need a separate form for every school you are applying to. If your daughter has a Statement of Education Needs or an Education, Health & Care Plan then your application has to be made through SENAR.

All applications for our school (St Paul's Catholic School for Girls) will require the following documentation to be included with the application form to assist the Governor's correctly match each applicant to the correct Criteria Point:

- 1) Proof of your home address (e.g. a copy of council tax, gas or electricity bill (within last 6 months);**
- 2) Copy of your daughter's Birth Certificate or passport;**
- 3) Copy of your daughter's Baptism Certificate; and**
- 4) a letter of support from your parish priest or the completed Supplementary Information Form.**

This form and all documentation must come back directly to us for the Governors to look at your application and make a decision as to whether a place can be offered or not. A letter will be sent out to you once the Governors have looked at any applications letting you know their decision.

If no place is available your daughter's name will be added to the relevant Year Groups Waiting List.

Please ensure that you collect the completed form from the Parish Priest and return it to St Paul's School for Girls.

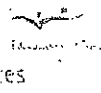
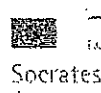
